Randall was born May 23, 1939 in Tacoma, Washington to Earl and Alice Fix. He graduated from Lincoln High School before going on to serve in the US Air Force for over 9 years. Randall enjoyed the military lifestyle so much he joined the US Army when he got out of the Air Force and served over 23 more years, completing 2 tours in the Vietnam War. He was stationed in Germany for a period of time and talked about how much he loved serving his country and how beautiful it was in Germany. Randall received numerous medals and honors while in the Military. He was a Military Police officer and after he retired, he became a Texas Police Officer in Copperas Cove, Texas for many years.

Randall married Peggy Campbell on October 29, 2005 in Comfort, Texas and they enjoyed traveling the country in their RV before finding a beautiful valley they settled in at Nampa, Idaho. Randall loved to ride motorcycles and they joined a small motorcycle group that met and rode every Tuesday. He belonged to SMART, a retired military group, and they moved back to Texas in July of 2021 to be closer to family. Randall was an active member of his local Cowboy Church.
